

4th Of July Parade





Samuel Meredith was born in Philadelphia in 1741. Young Samuel followed his father into the wool trade business, but political concerns attracted him. He fought in Gen. George Washington's army, rising through the ranks until, on April 5, 1777, he was commissioned brigadier general of the Fourth Brigade.

He must have earned favor with Washington because, on Friday, Sept. 11, 1789, Washington, then president of the United States, nominated Gen. Meredith treasurer of the United States, the first under the new nation's constitution. Samuel Meredith served in his post for 12 years under Presidents Washington, Adams and Jefferson until poor health and neglected personal affairs led him to retire.

About 1796, Gen. Meredith purchased a strip of land in Clinton, Mount Pleasant and Preston townships, Wayne County, some 20 miles long and 2 miles wide - nearly 26,000 acres. About 1800, he built a home at a cost of \$6,000. He called the estate Belmont. In 1801, Meredith retired to Belmont and spent the last sixteen years of his life there.

General Samuel Meredith died on Monday, Feb. 10, 1817, at 76. His wife survived him nearly four years, dying Sept. 20, 1820. They were both buried in the private burial-ground of the family, on the estate in northern Mount Pleasant township.
